A. the final earthquake that will occur on the Day of J

Q. How will the earth behave on the Day of J? Clue: Surah Zalzalah

A. it will give evidence against people

Q. How is our suffering in this world good for us?

A. It washes away our sins

Q. Why should we pay attention to the small sins?

A. They gather together and can destroy a person

Q. Where was Surah al-Adiyat revealed?

A. In Makkah

Q. What is the main theme of Surah al-Adiyat?

A. Ungratefulness of man

Q. What do the first 5 verses of Surah al-Adiyat begin with?

A. Oaths

Q. Which animal does Allah use in Surah al-Adiyat to give the message?

A. Horses

Surahs: qariah, Takathur, asr,

Q. Where was Surah al-Asr revealed ?

A. In Makkah

Q. How many ayat does Surah al-Asr have?

A. 3 ayaat

Q. What does Allah swear by in the 1st ayah of Surah al-Asr?

A. Time

Q. What does it mean when Allah swears by something?

A. It is something v. important

Q. What 4 things does Allah tells us to do in Surah al-Asr?

A. have Imaan, do good deeds, and encourage each other to truth and patience

Q. What is the Arabic word for inviting people to Islam?

A. Dawah

Q. What warning does Allah give in Surah al-Asr?

A. Man is in loss

Q. Where was Surah al-Takathur revealed?

A. Makkah

Q. What is the main theme of Surah al-Takathur?

A. Man is distracted from worshipping Allah by worldly things

Q. What is death often considered in Islam?

A. the ender of all pleasures

Q. What is the end result of people distracted by worldly things?

A. their end is Hellfire

Q. What is the true purpose of our life in the Dunya?

A. worship of Allah

Q. What does "al-Qar'iah" mean as the title?

A. "the Crashing blow"

Q. What is the title "al-Qariah" referring to?

A. the Day of Judgement

Q. Why is the Day of J called "the crashing blow"?

A. Its horrors will strike man with fear

Q. Give two more names given to the Day of Judgement.

A. al-Haqqah (the reality) and al-Ghashiyah (the overwhelming)

Q. What will man be like on the Day of J? *Clue: Surah al-Qariah.*

A. Like scattered moths.

Q. What will the mountains be like on the Day of J? *Clue: Surah al-Qariah.*

A. Like wool

Q. What reward does Surah al-Qariah says the good people will earn?

A. A pleasant life

Q. what name is given to the Hellfire in Surah al-Qariah?

A. "a bottomless pit" (al-Haawiyah)

Surahs: humazaha, fil, Quraish,

Q. What were Quraish?

A. They were a leading tribe in Makkah

Q. What did the tribe of Quraish do in Makkah?

A. They managed the pilgrims and put idols in Makkah

Q. Which 2 countries did Quraish send their caravans?

A. Syria and Yemen

Q. What had Quraish forgotten when their caravan returned safely?

A. It was a blessing from Allah

Q. Who was Abdul-Muttalib?

A. The grandfather of the Prophet (saw).

Q. What happened when Quraish accepted Islam?

A. All the idols were destroyed

Q. What is the main story of Surah al-Fil?

A. How Allah saved the Kaaba

Q. What is the name of the year in which the Prophet was born?

A. The year of the Elephant

Q. What is the name of the Christian ruler who wanted to destroy the Kaaba?

A. Abraha

Q. Why was Abdul Muttalib not worried about the Kaaba?

A. He knew Allah would take care of it.

Q. Why did Abraha want to destroy the Kaaba?

A. He wanted people to visit his own temple

Q. How did Allah destroy the army of Abraha?

A. He sent down flocks of birds with stones of baked clay

Q. How many ayat does Surah Humazah have?

A. 9 ayat

Q. Which kind of people does Surah Humazah insult?

A. people who insult others and find faults with them

Q. What does "Humazah" refer to?

A. making signs to make fun of someone

Q. What would Walid ibn Mughirah, the enemy of Islam do?

A. insult the believers

Q. What would Walid ibn Mughirah do with his money?

A. He would count it repeatedly and keep it for himself

Q. What name of the Hellfire does Surah al-Humazah give?

A. Al-Hutamah - it crushes whatever is in it.

Q. What are the effects of backbiting?

A. It cause division between people

Q. What kind of people does Surah al-Humazah tell us not to be like?

A. Greedy people and those who insult others

Surahs: kaafirun, kawthar, mauun

Q. Where was Surah al-Kafiroon revealed?

A. In Makkah

Q. What did the disbelievers want from the Prophet?

A. They wanted to worship their idols if they worshipped Allah

Q. Why was the disbeliever's idea to the prophet unacceptable?

A. No one deserves worship besides Allah

Q. What should Muslims never do with the disbelievers?

A. Never negotiate our religion with them

A. Unkind people, those who don't look after the orphans or poor people

Q. Why does Allah talk about the orphans and poor people?

A. Reminds us that it is our duty to look after them

A. Every good deed in Islam is considered as significant
