36. A reward from your Lord - a grossly sufficient bestowal.
37. Lord of the heavens and the earth, and all whatever is between them - the Most Gracious - with Whom no one will have the right to talk.
38. The day when Jibreel and all the angels will stand in rows; none will be able to speak except one whom the Most Gracious commands and who spoke rightly. *(Prophet Mohammed - peace and blessings be upon him - will be the first to be granted permission to intercede.)*
39. That is the True Day; therefore whoever wills may take the path towards his Lord.
40. We warn you of a punishment that has come near; a day on which man will see what his own hands have sent ahead, and the disbeliever will say, "Alas - if only I were dust
