

Kids Islamic Circle Lesson Plan

Session (1): The 10 days of Dhul Hijja				
Time	Activity	Notes	Comments	Resources
10 minutes	Introduction	Introduce yourself to the group and tell them about the ice breaker which would allow us to get to know each other.		
15 minutes	Ice breaker	Ask girls to sit next to someone they didn't know. Then, give out a doll template (can be purchased from Poundland in the UK) to each kid and ask them to interview each other. Questions could be about: name, age, hobbies, favourite food etc. Then go around the circle, starting from the right side, and each child told about their findings and presented the doll template to their partner at the end as a gift. 20 minutes	Main	As we were in the 10 Days of Dhul Hijja, I took the opportunity of sharing the "10 things to do in the 10 days of Dhul Hijja".	Note-taking skills	Notes of the lecture for this session. See website.
5 minutes	Discussion	Ask kids to share their thoughts and feelings about the first session.	Public speaking skills	
5 minutes	Activity	Give kids the chance to think and choose one of the ways the students will apply what has been learnt.	Reflection	
10 minutes	Activity	Each kid is given 2 minutes to share with the group which task they chose.	Presentation skills
